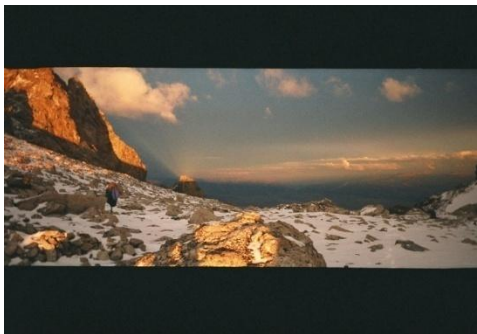

Cost

The Amazing Race

Design and Setup

Each team will need to develop a plan to locate the “Checkpoint Challenges” in a limited amount of time. At each checkpoint the team will have to obtain information, complete the task and record that information on their master sheet. The total number of checkpoints will be determined by the amount of time allotted and the physical challenge desired. The Checkpoints will combine cognitive and physical challenges, as well as incorporate various location specific resources.

Teams will need to develop a plan as to how they will navigate the course to optimize their time and efficiency. In the designated time frame, it is typically unlikely that the teams will be able to reach all the checkpoints. This requires communication and efficiency in executing the plan to optimize the overall performance.

Each team will receive GPS units, a map, two-way radios and additional “mission critical” information for overall success. Other resources can be vehicles that can range from SUV’s, bicycles, pedal cabs, scooters and segways.

Upon completing the course, teams gather back at the starting point to review their challenges and the winning Corporate Team will be awarded the CVR Award 2011. Special HFH mementos shall also be given to all staff of the winning company.

- Provide outdoor, team based Amazing Race event to include course navigation, GPS units, checkpoint challenges and scavenger hunt style initiatives
- The event will be fun, energizing and highlight client retreat objectives
